



Georgia S3DA 2026 Shooter of the Year (SOY) Rules

- ❖ The Archer must be a S3DA member in good standing at the time of award.
- ❖ The Archer must qualify for and compete in all GA S3DA State Tournaments. Archers who change equipment class or age divisions during the year or require a waiver to compete at State Championships will not be eligible for SOY honors.
- ❖ GA S3DA SOY points will be earned as follows:
 - **STATE CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS - Archers who place 1st through 10th will be awarded 10 pts for 1st, 9 pts for 2nd, 8 pts for 3rd, 7 pts for 4th, and so on through 10th place.**
 - **REGIONAL QUALIFIER EVENTS - (Maximum of 2 events from each discipline) Archers who place 1st through 5th will be awarded 5 pts for 1st, 4 pts for 2nd, 3 pts for 3rd, 2 pts for 4th, and 1 pt for 5th place.**
 - **Additionally, 3 points for each STATE and 1 point for each REGIONAL event will be awarded to each participating archer whose score is listed on the official results.**
 - **In the event of a tie SOY score after the final State Championship of the year, a shoot off will occur immediately after the tournament ends, using the tie breaker procedures for the discipline of the final State Tournament of the year.**
- ❖ GA S3DA SOY standings will be updated/posted after each qualifying event beginning with the 2nd event of the year.
- ❖ GA S3DA SOY awards will be awarded to the top male and female archer in each equipment class by age division, provided qualification requirements listed above are met, at the conclusion of the final GA S3DA State Championship. There are no requirements to participate outside your assigned region or to participate in a specific number of regional qualifiers.
